- 1) Appaloosa Halter, English Pleasure and Western Pleasure will be judged according to the Appaloosa Horse Club Rules
- Classes 14 & 15 are open to children 18 & under who have won 5 or fewer blue ribbons in under saddle classes prior to the current show season. Ribbons in Leadline, Walk-Trot and 4-H (Danish System) will not count.
- ω Classes 16 & 17 are open to adults who have won 5 or fewer blue ribbons in under saddle classes prior to the current show season. Ribbons in Leadline, Walk-Trot and 4-H (Danish System) will not count.
- 4 Classes 19 & 21 are open to any competitor who has not won a year end award in any under saddle class in any organization other than Walk-Trot and who has no blue ribbons in Walk-Trot-Canter class.
- 5) FTR Novice and Limit) prior to the current show season Classes 45 & 46 are open to adults who have not won a Hi-Point or Reserve Hi-Point year-end award in any club (excluding
